

## MIGRATION OF THE ROUTONS – FROM FRANCE TO HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE

### NORMANDY, FRANCE

The Fuquas were French Huguenots (Protestants) who lived in Normandy, a province of France. The Routons of today descended from the intermarriages of two French families– the Routons and the Fuquas.

### BUCKINGHAM COUNTY, VIRGINIA

The Routon and Fuqua families emigrated, before 1700, to Buckingham County, Virginia. Routons fought in the Revolutionary War and assisted with the war effort.

### LOGAN COUNTY, KENTUCKY

Philip and Reuben Routon migrated to Logan County, Kentucky in 1819. November 4, 1819, Philip Routon married Mary Penelope (Polly) Fuqua.

### HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE

From Logan County, Kentucky, Philip Routon moved in 1825 to Henry County, Tennessee.
